Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card. An AKC Measuring Official is scheduled to be at this trial. All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card (yellow form from a previous measurement) AND dogs who are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card MUST be measured prior to their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it.

Check-In

Self-serve check-in will start at 7:15 a.m. on Monday. Check in will be available by 8:15 on Tuesday. If your dog needs to be measured, please see the trial secretary for your armbands after your dog is measured. If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run.

Move-Ups:

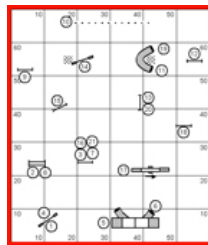
The pretrial move-up deadline is Monday, Oct 14th at 6:00 pm. Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.
